



Farm Bureau Deal

- Depending on the area where members are renting, members can save \$3 to \$30 a day on a vehicle rental.
- Also, most Hertz locations will give Farm Bureau members two free days of NeverLost (*NeverLost-equipped vehicles*), \$10 off a weekly rental (*Any reserved car class*), and up to \$15 off a weekend rental (*Any reserved car class*), with a Farm Bureau coupon. See “Additional perks with coupon” section below for details.

How does it work? (Nutshell Version)

Members make a reservation online or over the phone using the CDP code **0409226**. Next, members call Joel Benson 208-239-4289 or go to their local county office to receive a coupon.

Other Information/ (Broader Version)

How to make a reservation

Phone Instructions: Call 1-800-654-2210 use code **0409226** then call Joel Benson at 208-239-4289 (or email jbenson@idahofb.org) and have him mail you a coupon that must be present at the time of car rental or when the car is returned. Most county offices also have the coupons available.

Online Instructions: Usually cheaper than calling an operator.

1. Go to www.hertz.com
2. At the bottom of the reservation box there is a line that says **“I HAVE A DISCOUNT (CDP), COUPON OR OTHER OFFER”** **Check “Yes”**. After entering your information and pressing continue you will see a space listed as **Discount/CDP/Club Code: enter “0409226”**. Farm Bureau discount prices will now be shown instead of regular prices.
3. Call Joel Benson at 208-239-4289 and have him mail you a coupon that must be present at the time of car rental or when the car is returned. Most county offices also have coupons available.

Additional perks with coupon*

- Two Free Days of NeverLost (*NeverLost-equipped vehicles*)
- \$10 off a weekly rental (*Any reserved car class*)
- Up to \$15 off a weekend rental (*Any reserved car class*)

*These addition perks are subject to blackout and availability so members may want to call the renting location directly and make sure these apply.

Note: County offices also have coupons available.

Disclaimer: Corporate discount rates will be the lowest price almost every time. However on occasion, there may be times that a franchised location will have too many unused rentals on their lot and will be forced to low-ball a rate below a corporate rate. We advise our members to check out the regular prices, compare that to the Farm Bureau corporate rate, and take the best deal.
