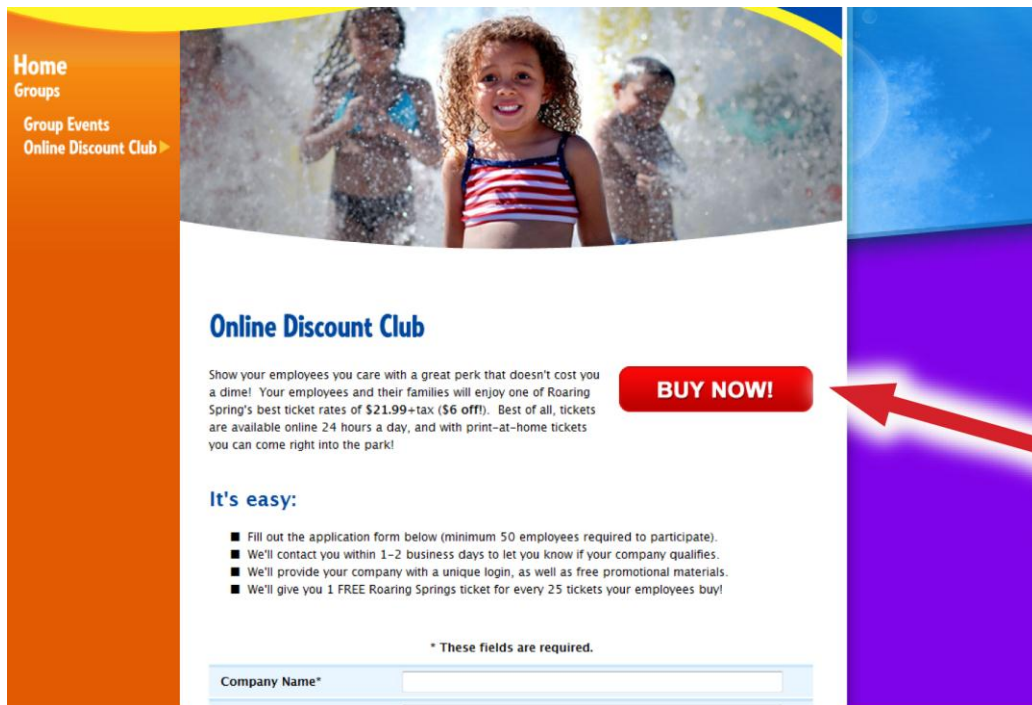
Online Instructions

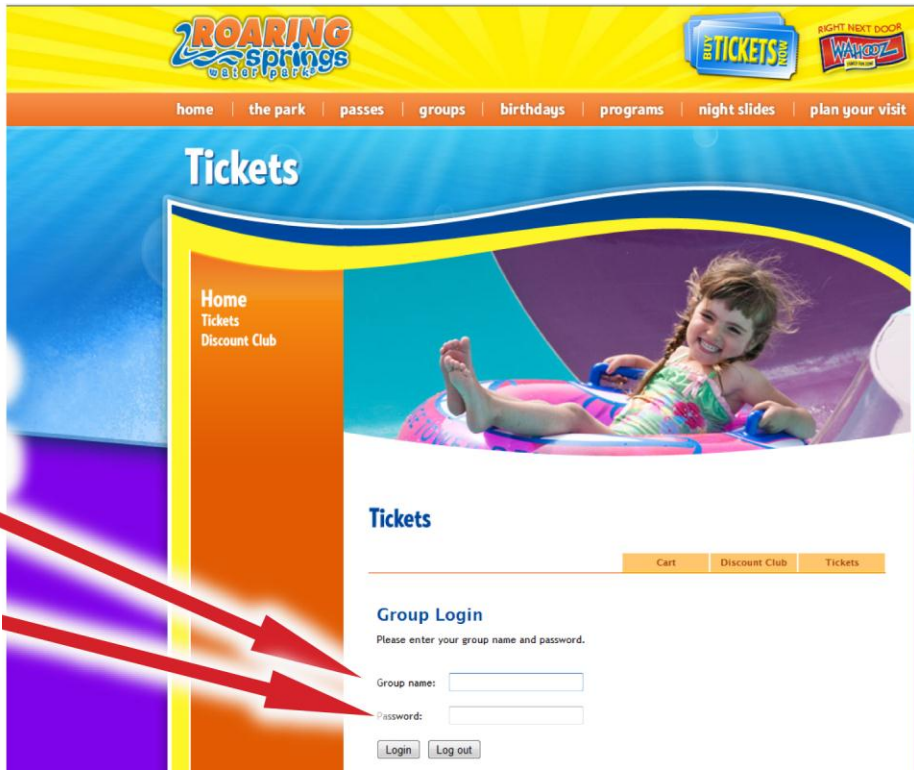

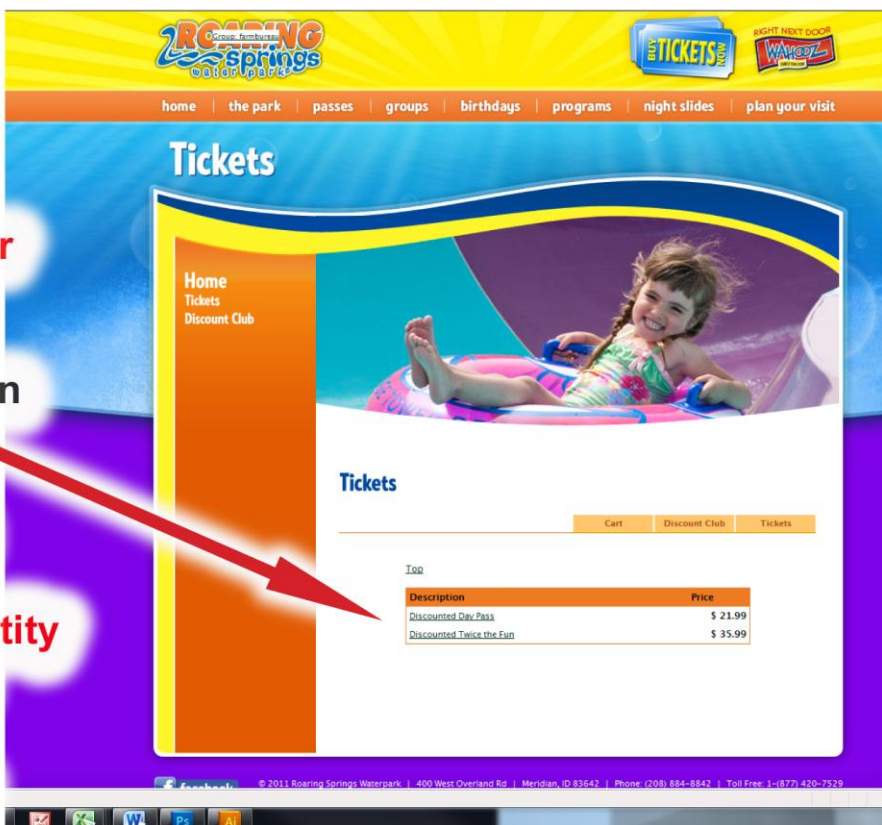

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: How do we find Roaring Springs?

A: Roaring Springs is located off I-84 at exit 44 in Meridian, Idaho. The park is approximately five miles west of Boise.

Q: Can we bring our own lifejackets?

A: You can bring in your own lifejackets, as long as they are US Coast Guard approved. Roaring Springs also has life jackets available at no additional charge. Swimsuits with built-in floatation devices are not Coast Guard approved, and are not allowed on some attractions.

Q: Can I leave the park and get back in?

A: All guests leaving the park and planning to return later that day are required to get a hand stamp prior to leaving the park.

Q: What can we wear on the water slides?

A: Appropriate swimwear is required, and subject to park approval. No bikini thongs, jeans, pants with rivets, belts, buckles or chains. Shoes and sunglasses are also not allowed on the rides. Swimsuits with built-in floatation devices are not Coast Guard approved, and are not allowed on some attractions. Swim diapers are required for children who aren't potty trained. Swim diapers are available for purchase in the gift shop.

Q: What are the height requirements for the rides?

A: For the safety of our guests, certain rides have height requirements: 42 inches for Mammoth Canyon Family Raft Ride, Rattlesnake Rapids and Double Trouble, 48 inches for Viper's Vortex and the Avalanche. There are many other rides for our smaller guests to enjoy, including two kiddie play areas.

Q: How much does it cost to rent a locker?

A: Small lockers are \$3 a day plus a \$3 deposit. Large lockers are \$6 a day plus a \$3 deposit. If you return your key at the end of the day you will receive your \$3 deposit back. Our lockers provide you with all day, unlimited access to your belongings.

Q: What if there's bad weather on the day of my visit?

A: If the water park attractions close due to bad weather you will be given a rain check to come back to the park another day. No refunds will be issued.

Q: What about my glasses?

A: You will be asked to hold your glasses in your hand when you go on the attractions.

Q: Can I wear water shoes or sandals on the attractions?

A: You can wear water shoes or sandals to walk around the park, but you will be asked to hold them in your hand when you go on the attractions.

Q: What if I have a disability?

A: Roaring Springs does its very best to accommodate guests with physical challenges. For more information on how we can meet your specific needs, please contact Roaring Springs at 884-8842 ext 0.

Q: What about my pet?

A: No pets are allowed in the water park. Pet Lodge provides doggie daycare, and is located approximately ¼ mile west of Roaring Springs on Overland Road. For your pet's safety, please don't leave them in your vehicle, RV, or tied up on Roaring Springs premises.

Q: Is there a tube rental fee?

A: All tubes required for the water slides are free of charge.

Q: Is there a fee to park?

A: All Roaring Springs parking is free of charge.
