Resorts in Utah



Through an agreement with the Utah Farm Bureau, members of the Idaho Farm Bureau can now purchase discounted tickets to some of the most popular ski resorts in Utah. Members can save around \$20 - \$25 per ticket. These resorts often change their daily rate depending on snow levels. Sometimes the first week or two of the season passes may actually be less expensive than the Farm Bureau price - but again this depends on daily snow levels.

Idaho Farm Bureau members can make arrangements for adult ski passes by calling the Utah Farm Bureau at 801-233-3010, Visa/MasterCard accepted, or by mailing a check for the number you need to Utah Farm Bureau Federation, 9865 South State Street, Sandy, UT 84070, Attn: Aurline Boyack or members can go directly to the 9865 South State Street address in Sandy and pick them up Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. until 4 p.m. These discounts are for Farm Bureau members only and members should have their membership # when they order passes/vouchers. If members need their membership number, they can call 208-239-4289 to receive that information. These passes are not dated so they can be ordered well in advance of anticipated use. They are, however, non-refundable. Deer Valley sells vouchers not passes and they have a black-out period from December 26, 2010 through January 1, 2011..

So how can I get these discount tickets to Idaho resorts?

Credit Card Option: Farm Bureau members can call Joel Benson at (208) 239-4289, use a credit card, and have the tickets and a receipt mailed to them. This applies for Bogus Basin, Pebble Creek, & Silver Mountain.

Bogus Basin Option: Bogus Basin tickets will also be distributed through the Ada County Office in Boise. This office is located at 1250 S. Allante and the contact person is Annie Scott (208-375-3411). Members may need to give

advanced notice when ordering Bogus Basin tickets to ensure this office has them available before the desired day of skiing. Members may still use the credit card option by calling Joel Benson.

Pebble Creek Option: Tickets for Pebble Creek may also be picked up at the Farm Bureau Headquarters or can check with a southeast Idaho county office. Members should call ahead to ensure that tickets are available at a given location. For information call Joel Benson (208-239-4289).

Silver Mountain Option: Members must show a valid Farm Bureau membership card at the ticket office.

Brundage Mountain Option: - Idaho Farm Bureau members must present a valid Farm Bureau membership card at the Brundage lift ticket window in order to receive the Farm Bureau discount rates with the discount applying only to the Farm Bureau cardholder. If a replacement membership card or additional spouse card is needed, please contact Peggy Moore at 208-239-4271. Discount is available during the entirety of the 2010-2011 winter season with no blackout dates. Discount applies only to single day passes which must be purchased at the ticket window. Discounts on any other Brundage lift ticket products or retail product (Select Cards, Season Passes, etc.) do not apply.
