All Idaho Farm Bureau members, employees, and their families.

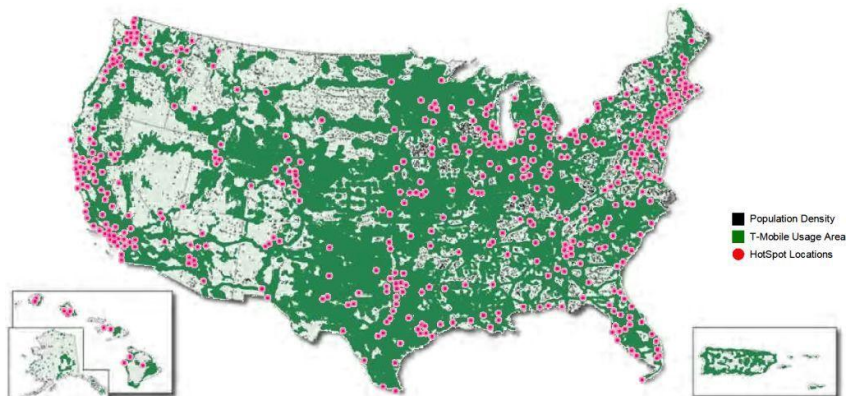
What are these Benefits?
